RECOMMENDED USE

- Use the product on a new trailer or after cleaning with water and mild soap.
- Put on protective gloves, clothing and glasses for the application of the product.
- Use this solution in a well-ventilated area and in case of insufficient ventilation, wear respiratory protection.
- Pour the product into a paint gun and apply the product to all galvanized sections.
- Drying time: 1 hour

USAGE RESTRICTIONS

- Do not apply product in the rain
- Do not apply product in an enclosed space (if you do so, a mask must be worn)

HAZARDS IDENTIFICATIONS

Health hazard class: Irritant

FIRST AID MEASURES

IRRITANT MIXTURE

Its repeated or prolonged contact with the skin or mucous membranes can cause irritant symptoms such as reddening of the skin, blisters, or dermatitis. Some of the symptoms may not be immediate. They can cause allergic reactions on the skin.

Description of first aid measures:

SKIN CONTACT

Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin vigorously with water and soap or a suitable skin cleaner. NEVER use solvents or thinners.

INGESTION

If accidentally ingested, seek immediate medical attention. Keep calm. NEVER induce vomiting.

EYE CONTACT

Remove contact lenses, if present and if it is easy to do. Wash eyes with plenty of clean and cool water for at least 10 minutes while pulling eyelids up, and seek medical assistance. Don't let the person to rub the affected eye.

INHALATION

Take the victim into open air; keep them warm and calm. If breathing is irregular or stops, perform artificial respiration.

INDICATION OF ANY IMMEDIATE MEDICAL ATTENTION AND SPECIAL TREATMENT NEEDED.

In case of doubt or when symptoms of feeling unwell persist, get medical attention. Never administer anything orally to persons who are unconscious. Cover the affected area with a dry sterile bandage. Protect the affected area from pressure or friction.

FIREFIGHTING MEASURES

Suitable extinguishing media

Extinguisher powder or CO₂. In case of more serious fires, also alcohol-resistant foam and water spray.

Unsuitable extinguishing media

Do not use a direct stream of water to extinguish. In the presence of electrical voltage, you cannot use water or foam as extinguishing media.

ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Contain and collect spillage with inert absorbent material (earth, sand, vermiculite, Kieselguhr...) and clean the area immediately with a suitable decontaminant.

Deposit waste in closed and suitable containers for disposal, in compliance with local and national regulations

HANDLING AND STORAGE

Precautions for safe storage

In the application area, smoking, eating, and drinking must be prohibited.

Store the containers between 5 and 25 °C, in a dry and well-ventilated place, far from sources of heat and direct solar light. Keep far away from ignition points. Keep away from oxidising agents and from highly acidic or alkaline materials.

Once the containers are open, they must be carefully closed and placed vertically to prevent spills.

EXPOSURE CONTROLS / PERSONAL PROTECTION

Safety measures

Wear protective gloves, clothing, and goggles.

In case of inadequate ventilation, wear respiratory protection.

Provide adequate ventilation, which can be achieved by using good local exhaust-ventilation and a good general exhaust system.
